

Groups trying to turn closed camp into state park

CHISAGO CITY, Minn.

A nonprofit group and others are trying to raise \$3.8 million to turn a closed camp in Chisago City into a state park. Camp Ojiketa closed two years ago, but the 71-acre parcel along Green Lake hasn't sold.

The nonprofit Trust for Public Land, city leaders and a group of former campers are trying to raise the funds to buy the camp.

The land is owned by the Minnesota Council of Camp Fire USA. Camp Ojiketa was founded in 1926 as a summer camp.
